## **BILL SUMMARY**:

Amends SL 1993-454, as amended, to authorize the Granville County Board of Commissioners to levy an additional room occupancy tax of up to 1%. Provides that the tax must be levied, administered, collected, and repealed in the same way as the existing tax. Effective October 1, 2007, requires the Granville County Tourism Development Authority (Authority) to use at least two-thirds of the total occupancy tax proceeds for capital expenditures for tourism-related projects and the remainder to promote travel and tourism. Beginning October 1, 2014, the Authority must use at least two-thirds of the proceeds to promote travel and tourism in Granville County and the remainder for tourism-related expenditures.

## **ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:**

Actual occupancy tax collections for Granville County in fiscal year 2004-05 were \$96,797. This was used as a base which was then grown out using Moody's economy.com consumer price index to give the following revenue stream.
