PUBLIC SCHOOLS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-81(b1) reads as rewritten:
"(b1) Both the standard course of study and the Basic Education Program shall include the
requirement that the public schools provide to all students two yearlong courses of instruction
on North Carolina history and geography. One yearlong course of instruction shall be provided
in elementary school, and one yearlong course of instruction shall be provided in middle
school. one yearlong course of instruction on North Carolina history and geography in
elementary school and one yearlong course of instruction in middle school on United States
history with North Carolina history integrated into this instruction. Each The course of
instruction shall include contributions to the history and geography of the State and the nation

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with the 2010-2011 school year.
