A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 OF AN ACT TO **AUTHORIZE** THE EXPANSION STATE-REIMBURSED 3 INTERPRETING SERVICES TO ENCOMPASS ALL COURT PROCEEDINGS IN 4 WHICH AN INTERPRETER IS NECESSARY TO ASSIST THE COURT IN THE 5 EFFICIENT TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS.
- 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 7
 - **SECTION 1.** G.S. 7A-314(f) reads as rewritten:

8 In any case in which the Judicial Department is bearing the costs of representation "(f) 9 for a party and that party or a witness for that party does not speak or understand the English language, and the court appoints a foreign language interpreter to assist that party or witness, 10 the reasonable fee for the interpreter's services is payable from funds appropriated to the 11 Administrative Office of the Courts. In order to facilitate the disposition of criminal or Chapter 12 50B cases, the The court may authorize the use of a court interpreter, paid from funds 13 appropriated to the Administrative Office of the Courts, in cases all proceedings in which an 14 15 interpreter is necessary to assist the court in the efficient transaction of business. The 16 appointment and payment shall be made in accordance with G.S. 7A-343(9c)."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009. 17
