

- 1 (2) A degree audit program showing the student exactly which courses are
2 needed to complete the degree in the student's initial field of study or in
3 another discipline.
- 4 (3) Providing academic advisers trained to assist an adult student with course
5 scheduling and to explain requirements and university procedures.
- 6 (4) A simplified application for readmission and waiver of the usual application
7 fee.
- 8 (5) Early admission and registration.
- 9 (6) Establishing an adult resource center on campus and providing adult student
10 services.

11 In addition, the Committee may consider any other issues that are relevant to
12 designing and implementing a statewide college access initiative for adults and may consider
13 any other issues relevant to this study.

14 **SECTION 3.** The Committee may make an interim report, including any
15 legislative recommendations, to the 2009 General Assembly, 2010 Regular Session, and shall
16 submit a final report, including any legislative recommendations, to the 2011 General
17 Assembly. The Committee shall terminate upon filing its final report or upon the convening of
18 the 2011 General Assembly, whichever is earlier.

19 **SECTION 4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the General
20 Assembly the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year and
21 the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year to be allocated
22 to the Legislative Services Commission and used to fund the work of the Committee
23 established by this act.

24 **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
