1		A BILL TO BE ENTITLED		
2	AN ACT TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO THE GENERAL STATUTES AS			
3	RECOMMENDED BY THE GENERAL STATUTES COMMISSION.			
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 120-29.1 reads as rewritten:			
6	"§ 120-29.1. Approval of bills.			
7	(a) If the Governor approves a bill, the Governor shall write upon the same, below the			
8	signatures of the presiding officers of the two houses, the fact, date, and time of approval, as			
9	follows: "Approvedm. this day of, " and shall sign			
10	the same as follows: " Governor". The Governor shall then return the approved bill to			
11	the enrolling clerk.			
12	(b) If any bill becomes law because of the failure of the Governor to take any action, it			
13	shall be the duty of the Governor to return the measure to the enrolling clerk, who shall sign the			
14	following certificate on the measure and deposit it with the Secretary of State: "This bill having			
15	been presented to the Governor for his-signature on the day of,			
16	and the Governor having failed to approve it within the time prescribed by law, the same is			
17	hereby declared to have become a law.			
18	This day of,, Enrolling Clerk".			
19	(c) If the Governor returns any bill to the house of origin with his-objections, the			
20	Governor shall write such objections on the measure or cause the objections to be attached to			
21	the measure. When any such bill becomes law after reconsideration of the two houses, the			
22	principal clerk of the second house to act shall, below the objections of the Governor, sign the			
23	following certificate: "Became law notwithstanding the objections of the Governor,			
24 25		this day of,". The principal clerk of the		
25 26		shall fill in the time. The enrolling clerk shall deposit the measure	with the	
26 27	Secretary of S		Constino	
27		calculating the period under Section 22(7) of Article II of the North		
28 29	Constitution, the day on which the bill is presented to the Governor shall be excluded and the entire last day of the period is included."			
29 30	<b>SECTION 2.</b> The Revisor of Statutes may cause to be printed all explanatory			
30 31	comments of the drafters of S.L. 2009-222, 2009-267, and 2009-318 as the Revisor deems			
32	appropriate.
