| 4  | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:   |
| 5  | <b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 143B-475.2 reads as rewritten:  |
| 6  | "§ 143B-475.2. Fees for services.  |
| 7  | A fee in the amount set by the Department is imposed on the entities listed in this              |
| 8  | section. Program service fees shall be established for all program services except for excess    |
| 9  | property acquisition and first responder assistance services rendered. The fees are departmental |
| 10 | receipts and are applied to the Department's costs in providing services to these entities. The  |
| 11 | fees apply to the following:   |
| 12 | (1) A local-law enforcement agency that employs more than 25 officers and that                   |
| 13 | receives equipment from the Department, whether by transfer, loan, or                            |
| 14 | procurement under an agreement with the United States Department of                              |
| 15 | Defense.   |
| 16 | (2) A person for whom the Department stores evidence."   |
| 17 | SECTION 2. There is appropriated form the General Fund to the Department of                      |
| 18 | Crime Control and Public Safety, Law Enforcement Support Services Division, for fiscal year      |
| 19 | 2010-2011, the sum of five hundred seventy-eight thousand dollars (\$578,000) to support the     |
| 20 | Division's operating costs.  |
| 21 | SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2010. The fees associated with this                |
| 22 | act shall take effect no later that January 1, 2011.   |
