2	AN ACT TO CHANGE THE TIME PERIOD FOR WHICH AN AGGRIEVED PARTY MAY			
3	REQUEST AN ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING BEFORE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR			
4	VEHICLES FOR A VIOLATION OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTION			
5	PROGRAM STATUTES.			
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-183.8G(b) reads as rewritten:			
8	"(b) Hearing After Statement of Charges. – When a license holder receives a statement			
9	of charges of a violation that could result in the suspension or revocation of the person's			
10 11	license, the person can obtain a hearing by making a request for a hearing. The person must make the request to the Division within 10 days after receiving the statement of the charges. A			
12	person who does not request a hearing within this time limit waives the right to a hearing.			
12	The Division must hold a hearing requested under this subsection within three business15			
14	days after receiving the request unless the person requesting the hearing asks for additional			
15	time to prepare for the hearing.request. A person may ask for no more than seven additional			
16	business days to prepare. If the additional time requested is within this limit, the Division must			
17	grant a person the additional time requested. The hearing must be held at the location			
18	designated by the Division. Suspension or revocation of the license is stayed until a decision is			
19	made following the hearing.			
20	If a person does not request a hearing within the time allowed for making the request, the			
21	proposed suspension or revocation becomes effective the day after the time for making the			
22	request ends. If a person requests a hearing but does not attend the hearing, the proposed			
23	suspension or revocation becomes effective the day after the date set for the hearing."			
24	SE	<b>ECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
