2 AN ACT TO REPEAL THE TWO-WEEK DISQUALIFICATION FOR UNEMPLOYMENT 3 COMPENSATION BENEFITS AS A RESULT OF LEAVING WORK TO 4 ACCOMPANY A SPOUSE TO A NEW PLACE OF RESIDENCE FOR WORK IN A 5 DIFFERENT LOCATION AND TO MAKE THOSE BENEFITS NONCHARGEABLE 6 TO THE EMPLOYER. 7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 8 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 96-14(1d) reads as rewritten: "(1d) For the purposes of this Chapter, any claimant leaving work to accompany 9 the claimant's spouse to a new place of residence where that spouse has 10 secured work in a location that is too far removed for the claimant 11 reasonably to continue his or her work shall serve a time certain 12 disqualification for benefits for a period of two weeks beginning the first day 13 of the first week after the disqualifying act occurs with respect to which 14 week an individual files a claim for benefits.constitute good cause for 15 leaving work. Notwithstanding the other provisions of this subdivision, any 16 claimant leaving work to accompany the claimant's spouse to a new place of 17 residence because the spouse has been reassigned from one military 18 assignment to another shall be deemed good cause for leaving work. 19 20 Benefits paid on the basis of this subdivision shall not be charged to the account of the employer." 21 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law. 22
