## SESSION LAW 2010-35 HOUSE BILL 901

## AN ACT DIRECTING THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO DEVELOP OR IDENTIFY ACADEMICALLY RIGOROUS HONORS-LEVEL COURSES IN HEALTHFUL LIVING EDUCATION THAT CAN BE OFFERED AT THE HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-81 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(e2) <u>Honors-Level Courses in Healthful Living Education to be Developed and</u> <u>Administered. – The State Board of Education shall develop or identify academically rigorous</u> <u>honors-level courses in healthful living education that can be offered at the high school level.</u> <u>These honors-level courses shall be more rigorous than standard-level courses, include</u> <u>advanced content, provide multiple opportunities for students to take greater responsibility for</u> their learning, and require higher quality work from the students than standard courses."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
