6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 113-169.1 reads as rewritten:
8	"§ 113-169.1. Permits for gear, equipment, and other specialized activities
9	authorized.authorized; individual transferable fishing quotas for striped bass
10	management.
11	(a) The Commission may adopt rules to establish permits for gear, equipment, and
12	specialized activities, including commercial fishing operations that do not involve the use of a
13	vessel and transplanting oysters or clams.
14	(b) The Commission may adopt rules to establish gear specific permits to take striped
15	bass from the Atlantic Ocean and to limit the number and type of these permits that may be
16	issued to a person.permits and individual transferable fishing quotas to take striped bass and to
17	provide for the allocation of these permits and quotas. The Commission may establish a fee for
18	each permit or individual transferable fishing quota established pursuant to this subsection in an
19	amount that compensates the Division for the administrative costs associated with the permit
20	but that does not exceed ten dollars (\$10.00) per permit."
21	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
