12	specialized activities, including commercial fishing operations that do not involve the use of a		
13	vessel and transplanting oysters or clams.		
14		he Commission may adopt rules to establish gear specific permits to take sta	-
15	bass from the Atlantic Ocean and to limit the number and type of these permits that may be		
16	issued to a person permits and individual transferable fishing quotas to take striped bass and to		
17	provide for the allocation of these permits and quotas. The Commission may establish a fee for		
18	each permit or individual transferable fishing quota established pursuant to this subsection in an		
19	amount that compensates the Division for the administrative costs associated with the permit		
20		not exceed ten dollars (\$10.00) per permit."
