9	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
10	SECTION 1. G.S. 166A-5(3) is amended by adding a new sub-subdivision to read:		
11	"(3) Functions of State Emergency Management. – The functions of the State		
12	emergency management program include:

14	<u>b2.</u> <u>Establishment of a voluntary model registry for use by political</u>		
15	subdivisions in identifying functionally and medically fragile persons		
16	in need of assistance during a disaster. Any health information		
17	obtained pursuant to this sub-subdivision is confidential and is not a		
18	public record pursuant to G.S. 132-1 or any other applicable statute.		
19 20	This information shall be used only for the purposes set forth in this sub-subdivision.		
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22	SECTION 2. G.S. 166A-7(d) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:		
23	"(d) In carrying out the provisions of this Article each political subdivision is authorized:		
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25	(5) To coordinate the voluntary registration of functionally and medically fragile		
26	persons in need of assistance during a disaster either through a registry		
27	established by this subdivision or by the State. Any health information		
28	obtained pursuant to this subdivision is confidential and is not a public		
29	record pursuant to G.S. 132-1 or any other applicable statute. This		
30	information shall be used only for the purposes set forth in this subdivision."		
31	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
