February 26, 2009 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT MAKING A PUBLIC RECORD ANY COMMUNICATION BY A PUBLIC OFFICER REGARDING THE QUALIFICATIONS OF AN APPLICANT FOR STATE EMPLOYMENT OR APPOINTMENT. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Chapter 132 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 132-11. Public officer communications regarding applicants for public employment. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any document or communication produced by a public officer (State or local) with respect to a person seeking a position of public employment or appointment with any State agency to recommend or discourage the employment or appointment of that person is a public record under this Chapter."



**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
