SCIENCES TO SUPPORT THE SOLDIER INSTITUTE FOR REGENERATIVE		
MEDICINE.		
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Wake Forest		
University Health Sciences, a nonprofit organization, the sum of four million dollars		
(\$4,000,000) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year for the Wake Forest Institute for Regenerative		
Medicine. These funds shall be used to provide support for the Department of Defense Soldier		
Institute for Regenerative Medicine and infrastructure support for a Good Manufacturing		
Practice facility to be located at the Piedmont Triad Research Park in Forsyth County.		

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
