Short Title: Small Farm Profitability/Egg Sales. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO INCREASE SMALL FARM PROFITABILITY BY INCREASING THE  
3 EXEMPTION FOR SALES OF UNGRADED EGGS, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE  
4 HOUSE SELECT COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURAL REGULATIONS.  
5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  
6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 106-245.15 reads as rewritten:  
7 "**§ 106-245.15. Designation of grade and class on containers required; conformity with**  
8 **designation; exemption.**  
9 No person shall market to consumers, institutional consumers or retailers or expose for that  
10 purpose any eggs unless there is clearly designated therewith on the container the grade and  
11 size or weight class established in accordance with the provisions of this Article and such eggs  
12 shall conform to the designated grade and size or weight class (except when sold on contract to  
13 a United States governmental agency); provided, however, a producer marketing eggs of his  
14 own production shall be exempt from this section when such marketing occurs on the premises  
15 where the eggs are produced, processed, or when ungraded sales do not exceed ~~30~~150 dozen  
16 per week."  
17 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
