February 28, 2011 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED ACT **AUTHORIZING** LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION **ADOPT** CONSOLIDATED CALENDARS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-84.2 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(d1) Consolidated Calendar. – Notwithstanding subsections (a) and (d) of this section, a local board of education may elect to save money by consolidating the school calendar. The consolidated calendar shall include a minimum of 180 days or 1,000 hours of instruction covering at least nine calendar months. If a local board of education complies with this subsection by scheduling 1,000 hours of instruction on less than 180 days, teachers employed for a 10-month term are deemed to have been employed for 180 instructional days."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
