- 2 AN ACT TO REPEAL THE LAW THAT AUTHORIZES IN-STATE TUITION STATUS 3
 - FOR OUT-OF-STATE STUDENTS WHO ARE AWARDED FULL SCHOLARSHIPS.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5
 - **SECTION 1.** G.S. 116-143.6 is repealed.

SECTION 2. The repeal of G.S. 116-143.6 by Section 1 of this act does not affect 6 the receipt of full scholarships by students who received the scholarships prior to the effective 7 8 date except as follows: a student's eligibility for in-State tuition provided pursuant to G.S. 116-143.6 is limited to a cumulative total of eight academic semesters. 9

10 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
