2	AN ACT AMENDING THE NORTH CAROLINA PSYCHOLOGY PRACTICE ACT TO
3	ALLOW PERSONS CERTIFIED AS BEHAVIOR ANALYSTS AND ASSISTANT
4	BEHAVIOR ANALYSTS BY THE BEHAVIOR ANALYST CERTIFICATION BOARD
5	TO PRACTICE BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS AND THERAPY UNDER CERTAIN
6	CIRCUMSTANCES.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 90-270.4 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
9	"(f1) Nothing in this Article shall be construed to prevent a Board Certified Behavior
10	Analyst (BCBA) or a Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analyst (BCaBA) from offering
11	services within the scope of practice authorized by the Behavior Analyst Certification Board,
12	including behavior analysis and therapy, in accordance with professional standards of the
13	BCBA or BCaBA's certification if (i) the BCBA or BCaBA is properly certified and in good
14	standing with the Behavior Analyst Certification Board and (ii) the BCBA or BCaBA does not
15	hold himself or herself out to the public by any title or description stating or implying that the
16	BCBA or BCaBA is a psychologist or licensed, certified, or registered to practice psychology
17	in this State."
18	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
