3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
4	SECTION 1. Article 7A of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by		
5	adding a new section to read:		
6	" <u>§ 14-27.3A. Third degree rape.</u>		
7	<u>(a)</u> <u>A</u>	person commits the offense of third degree rape if the person continues t	o engage
8	in the act of vaginal intercourse with another person after consent is withdrawn.		
9	<u>(b)</u> <u>A</u>	person who initially consents to vaginal intercourse is not deemed	to have
10	consented to any penetration that occurs after the person withdraws consent during the course		
11	of that vaginal intercourse. A person may withdraw consent to engage in vaginal intercourse		
12	during the intercourse, even if any actual penetration is in progress or accomplished with		
13	consent and even if there is only one act of vaginal intercourse. The withdrawal of consent		
14	must be clearly communicated in a way that a reasonable person would understand to constitute		
15	withdrawal of consent.		
16	<u>(c)</u> <u>A</u>	violation of this section is a Class E felony."

18	offenses committed on or after that date.
