13	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
14	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board	
15	Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two hundred thousand doll	
16	(\$200,000) for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred thousand doll	
17	(\$200,000) for the 2012-2013 fiscal year to be allocated to the University of North Carolina	
18	Chapel Hill Injury Prevention Research Center to provide training on injury prevention	for
19	professionals in North Carolina.	
20	SECTION 2. The Injury Prevention Research Center shall coordinate its train	
21	efforts with the Department of Health and Human Services, Injury and Violence Prevent	
22	Branch, and shall provide annual reports on training to the Branch and to the Gene	ral
23	Assembly.	
24	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2011.
