## SENATE BILL 155 RATIFIED BILL

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE TOWNS OF GARNER, KNIGHTDALE, MORRISVILLE, WENDELL, AND ZEBULON AND THE CITIES OF DURHAM AND WINSTON-SALEM TO COLLECT DELINQUENT STORMWATER UTILITY FEES IN THE SAME MANNER AS THEY MAY COLLECT DELINQUENT PERSONAL AND REAL PROPERTY TAXES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of S.L. 2005-441 reads as rewritten: "SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to stream-clearing activities commenced on or after that date. Section 3 of this act applies only to the <u>Cities of</u> <u>Durham and Winston-Salem, the TownTowns</u> of <u>Garner, Kernersville</u> <u>Kernersville</u>, <u>Knightdale, Morrisville, Wendell, and Zebulon,</u> and the Village of Clemmons." SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 8<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2011.
