AN ACT ADOPTING THE TOWN OF GRIFTON'S SHAD FESTIVAL AS THE OFFICIAL		
SHAD FESTIVAL OF THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA.		
Whereas, the Grifton Shad Festival, held annually since 1970, is the oldest festival		
in Pitt County and one of the longest running festivals in eastern North Carolina; and		
Whereas, the Grifton Shad Festival provides visitors with many family-oriented		
activities, such as a parade, arts and crafts, and historical exhibits; and		
Whereas, each year, citizens in the area demonstrate their community pride by		
volunteering to make the festival a success; Now, therefore,		
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SI	ECTION 1. Chapter 145 of the General Statutes is amended by	adding a new
section to read:		
" <u>§ 145-33. State shad festival.</u>		
The Grifton Shad Festival is adopted as the official shad festival of the State of North		
<u>Carolina.</u> "		
SI	ECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
