A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE DISABLED VETERAN PROPERTY TAX HOMESTEAD 3 EXCLUSION. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 105-277.1C(a) reads as rewritten: 6 Exclusion. - A permanent residence owned and occupied by an owner who is a North Carolina resident and who is an honorably discharged disabled veteran or the unmarried 7 surviving spouse of an honorably discharged disabled veteran is designated a special class of 8 9 property under Article V, Section 2(2) of the North Carolina Constitution and is taxable in accordance with this section. The first forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000)sixty-five thousand 10 dollars (\$65,000) of appraised value of the residence is excluded from taxation. An owner who 11 receives an exclusion under this section may not receive other property tax relief." 12 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective for taxable years beginning on or after July 1, 13

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2011.
