SECTION 1. G.S. 20-141.4(b) reads as rewritten:

- Punishments. Unless the conduct is covered under some other provision of law "(b) providing greater punishment, the following classifications apply to the offenses set forth in this section:
 - Aggravated felony death by vehicle is a Class D-C felony. (1)
- Felony death by vehicle is a Class E-D felony. 15 (2)
 - Aggravated felony serious injury by vehicle is a Class E felony. (3)
- Felony serious injury by vehicle is a Class F felony. 17 (4)
- 18 Misdemeanor death by vehicle is a Class A1 misdemeanor."
- **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2011, and applies to 19 20 offenses committed on or after that date.
