Each licensee shall complete 10 continuing education 18 units per year. Failure to obtain continuing education units shall result in the forfeiture of a 19 license. The Board may suspend a licensee's license for 30 days for failure to obtain continuing 20 education units required by this subsection. Upon payment of a reinstatement fee, the license shall be reinstated. Failure to request a reinstatement of the license and payment of the 21 22 reinstatement fee shall result in the forfeiture of a license. Disciplinary action. 40 The Board may deny, restrict, suspend, or revoke a license or refuse to issue or (a) 41 renew a license if a licensee or applicant: 42 Employs the use of fraud, deceit, or misrepresentation in obtaining or (1)43 attempting to obtain a license or the renewal of a license. 44 Practices or attempts to practice irrigation construction or contracting by (2)45 fraudulent misrepresentation. 46 (3) Commits an act of gross malpractice or incompetence as determined by the 47 Board. 48 Has been convicted of or pled guilty or no contest to a crime that indicates (4) 49 that the person is unfit or incompetent to practice as an irrigation contractor 50 or that indicates that the person has deceived or defrauded the public. Has been declared incompetent by a court of competent jurisdiction. 51 (5)

2	the Board.
3	(7) Uses or attempts to use the seal in a fraudulent or unauthorized manner.
4	(8) Fails to file the required surety bond or letter of credit or to keep the bond or
5	letter of credit in force.
6	(b) The Board may assess costs, including attorneys' fees, in a proceeding under this
7	section against an applicant or licensee found to be in violation of this Chapter."
8	SECTION 7. The Revisor of Statutes shall change the phrase "irrigation
9	construction or contracting" to "irrigation construction or irrigation contracting" wherever it
10	appears in Chapter 89G of the General Statutes.
11	SECTION 8. This act becomes effective October 1, 2011.
