5	SECTION 1. Article 3 of Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding

8	security interests.		
9	<u>Notwithst</u>	tanding any other provision of law, a lease transaction does not create a	a sale or
10	security inter-	est in a motor vehicle or trailer merely because the lease contains a termin	al rental
11	adjustment clause that provides that the rental price is permitted or required to be adjusted up or		
12	down by reference to the amount of money realized upon the sale or other disposition of the		
13	motor vehicle	e or trailer."	
14	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
