- 2 AN ACT ADJUSTING THE DATES OF VALIDITY FOR LICENSES ISSUED BY THE 3 WILDLIFE RESOURCES COMMISSION TO ELIMINATE THE PENALTY FOR 4 EARLY RENEWAL.
- The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 6
 - SECTION 1. G.S. 113-270.1B reads as rewritten:

7 "§ 113-270.1B. License required to hunt, fish, or trap.

8 Except as otherwise specifically provided by law, no person may hunt, fish, trap, or (a) 9 participate in any other activity regulated by the Wildlife Resources Commission for which a license is provided by law without having first procured a current and valid license authorizing 10 11 the activity.

12 (b) Except as indicated otherwise, all licenses are annual licenses valid from the date of issue for a period of 12 months.months from the effective date printed on the face of the 13 14 license.

- 15 As used in this section, the term "effective date" means the later of: (c)
- The date of purchase of a new license. 16 (1)
- The first day after the expiration of a currently valid license of the same type 17 (2)held by the licensee." 18
- **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2012. 19
