"§ 104E-9.1. Restrictions on use and operation of tanning equipment. (a) Operators of tanning equipment and owners of tanning facilities subject to rules adopted pursuant to this Chapter shall comply with or ensure compliance with the following:

(2)	The operator shall not allow a person 13 years and youngerless than 18 years old to use tanning equipment without a written prescription from the person's medical physician specifying the nature of the medical condition requiring the treatment, the number of visits, and the time of exposure for each visit.equipment.
