

"(7) The State Health Plan for Teachers and State Employees in administering the provisions of ~~Article 3A~~ Article 3B of Chapter 135 of the General Statutes."

SECTION 2.11.(b) Sections 1.2 and 1.3(a) of this act are repealed.

STATEMENT OF LEGISLATIVE INTENT REGARDING REPEAL OF LANGUAGE

SECTION 2.12. In repealing a specific, detailed provision of Article 3A of Chapter 135 of the General Statutes and not placing that detailed provision into Article 3B of Chapter 135 of the General Statutes, it is not necessarily the intent of the General Assembly to prohibit the State Treasurer or the State Health Plan from having that authority.

CARRYOVER OF RULES AND POLICIES

SECTION 2.13. Rules and policies adopted by the Executive Administrator and the Board of Trustees prior to the effective date of this section shall continue to be in effect unless the rule or policy directly conflicts with a provision of Article 3B of Chapter 135 of the General Statutes or until the State Treasurer changes the rule or policy.

EFFECTIVE DATE FOR PART II

SECTION 2.14. Except as otherwise provided, Part II of this act becomes effective January 1, 2012.

EFFECT OF HEADINGS




EFFECTIVE DATE
