## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO PROHIBIT COMMUNITY APPEARANCE COMMISSIONS, CITIES, AND
3	COUNTIES FROM REQUIRING THAT NURSERY STOCK THAT IS PURCHASED
4	WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE COMMISSION, CITY, OR COUNTY
5	RESPECTIVELY MEET ANY STANDARD FOR NURSERY STOCK THAT IS
6	STRICTER THAN THE AMERICAN STANDARD FOR NURSERY STOCK ADOPTED
7	BY THE AMERICAN NURSERY AND LANDSCAPE ASSOCIATION, UNLESS THE
8	STRICTER STANDARD IS NECESSARY TO PROTECT PUBLIC HEALTH OR
9	SAFETY.
10	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
11	SECTION 1. Part 7 of Article 19 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes is
12	amended by adding a new section to read:
13	"§ 160A-455.1. Restriction concerning standards in excess of national standards
14	applicable to nursery stock.
15	No commission may make any plans or carry out any program under this Part to enhance
16	the visual quality or aesthetic appearance of the municipality or county within its jurisdiction
17	that will require that any nursery stock that is purchased to be planted within its jurisdiction
18	satisfy any standard that exceeds the American Standard for Nursery Stock adopted by the
19	American Nursery and Landscape Association, unless the stricter standard is necessary to
20	protect public health or safety."
21	<b>SECTION 2.</b> Article 21 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes is amended by
22	adding a new section to read:
23	" <u>§ 160A-499.4. Standards for nursery stock.</u>
24	No city may require that any nursery stock that is purchased to be planted within its
25	jurisdiction satisfy any standard for nursery stock that exceeds the American Standard for
26	Nursery Stock adopted by the American Nursery and Landscape Association, unless the stricter
27	standard is necessary to protect public health or safety."
28	<b>SECTION 3.</b> Article 23 of Chapter 153A of the General Statutes is amended by
29	adding a new section to read:
30	" <u>§ 153A-457. Standards for nursery stock.</u>
31	No county may require that any nursery stock that is purchased to be planted within its
32	jurisdiction satisfy any standard for nursery stock that exceeds the American Standard for
33	Nursery Stock adopted by the American Nursery and Landscape Association, unless the stricter
34	standard is necessary to protect public health or safety."
35	<b>SECTION 4.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to any contracts
36	for the purchase of nursery stock made on or after that date.
