AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM OR BOW AND ARROW
FROM THE RIGHT-OF-WAY IN BEAUFORT COUNTY.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. It is unlawful to discharge a firearm or bow and arrow, or to attemp
to discharge a firearm or bow and arrow, from, on, across, or over the roadway or right-of-way
of any public road.
SECTION 2. Violation of the provisions of this act is punishable as a Class 3
misdemeanor.
SECTION 3. This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife
Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by other peace officers with
general subject matter jurisdiction.
SECTION 4. This act applies only to Beaufort County.
SECTION 5 This act becomes effective October 1, 2013, and applies to offenses
