The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SE	ECTION 1. G.S. 20-81.12(b4) reads as rewritten:
"(b4) Ol	ympic Games The Division may not issue an Olympic Games special plate
unless it rece	tives 300 or more applications for the plate and the U.S. Olympic Committee
licenses, with	out charge, the State to develop a plate bearing the Olympic Games symbol and
name. The Di	vision must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction
Plate Accoun	t derived from the sale of Olympic Games plates to the N.C. Health and Fitness
Foundation, Inc., North Carolina Amateur Sports, which will allocate the funds as follows:	
(1)	Fifty percent (50%)Sixty-seven percent (67%) to the U.S. Olympic
	Committee to assist in training olympic Olympic athletes.
(2)	Twenty-five percent (25%)Thirty-three percent (33%) to North Carolina
	Amateur Sports to assist with administration of the State Games of Nortl
	Carolina.
(3)	Twenty five percent (25%) to the Governor's Council on Physical Fitnes

and Health to support local fitness council development throughout North

Carolina."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2013.
