SENATE BILL 441

Short Title: State Highway Patrol/Reside in Same County. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A MEMBER OF THE STATE HIGHWAY PATROL SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO RESIDE IN THE COUNTY OF THEIR ASSIGNED DUTY STATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Article 4 of Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

**"§ 20-192.1. Residence of members.**

A member of the State Highway Patrol shall not be required to reside in the same county that his or her duty station is located; provided that, a member shall not reside in a location that would prevent him or her from responding in a timely manner to a call for service."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
