1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WILSON TO CONTINUE THE PROVISION OF
3 COMMUNICATION SERVICES IN THE CITY'S TEMPORARY EXTENSION AREAS
4 UNTIL THIRTY DAYS AFTER ALTERNATIVE SERVICE IS ESTABLISHED.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 160A-340.2(c)(3) reads as rewritten:

7 "(c) The provisions of G.S. 160A-340.1, 160A-340.3, 160A-340.4, 160A-340.5, and
8 160A-340.6 do not apply to a city or joint agency providing communications service as of
9 January 1, 2011, provided the city or joint agency limits the provision of communications
10 service to any one or more of the following:

12 (3) The following service areas:

14 c. For the city of Wilson, the service area is the county limits of Wilson
15 County, including the incorporated areas within the County.
16 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article, the city of
17 Wilson may continue the provision of communication services to
18 persons and businesses in the temporary extension areas under the
19 condition that the provision of communication services in such areas
20 is terminated by a date which is 30 days after the date retail service is
21 first available in the area from a competitive provider of
22 communications service that will provide Fiber to the Premises
23 (FTTP) service. For purposes of this subdivision, "temporary
24 extension areas" shall mean (i) the corporate limits of the Town of
25 Pinetops and (ii) any service connection located within 800 feet of
26 the centerline of Christian Road (State Road No. 1942) between its
27 intersection with Bloomery Road (State Road No. 1996) and West
28 Hornes Church Road (State Road No. 1941). Prior to the cessation of
29 service, the city of Wilson may establish rates, fees, charges, and
30 penalties for the communication services provided in the temporary
31 extension areas in the same manner as communication services
32 provided in the county limits of Wilson County, including the
33 incorporated areas within the County. Service will be deemed
34 available for purposes of this provision upon the certification by a
35 competitive provider to the city that service is available in a
36 temporary extension area. For purposes of this subdivision, a



1 competitive provider is an incumbent local exchange carrier or cable
2 telecommunications company that is not presently providing Fiber to
3 the Premises (FTTP) service in the temporary extension areas.

5 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
