## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO CONFORM THE LAW ON THE COMPENSATION OF APPRAISERS BY 3 APPRAISAL MANAGEMENT COMPANIES TO THE FEDERAL 4 TRUTH-IN-LENDING ACT AS INTERPRETED BY THE CONSUMER FINANCIAL 5 PROTECTION BUREAU'S REGULATION Z AND TO REPLACE AN INCONSISTENT 6 REFERENCE TO PRINCIPAL DWELLINGS WITH A REFERENCE TO ONE- TO 7 FOUR-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DWELLINGS. 8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 9

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 93E-2-4(i) reads as rewritten:

10 For appraisal assignments of property secured by the principal dwelling of the "(i) 11 consumer, one- to four-family residential dwellings, an appraisal management company shall 12 compensate appraisers in compliance with section 129E(i) of the federal Truth in Lending Act (15 U.S.C. § 1601 et seq.) and regulations promulgated thereunder. The Board shall adopt rules 13 necessary to enforce this subsection. Rules establishing customary and reasonable rates shall be 14 15 based on objective third-party information, such as academic studies and independent private 16 sector surveys." 17

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes retroactively effective January 1, 2017.
