(2a) To provide assistance, upon approval by the Executive Director of the North
`	Carolina State Firefighters' Association, to a destitute member firefighter who
	has served or is serving honorably for at least five years, with a certified fire
	department. The determination of destitute shall be based on the inability of the
	firefighters, through no fault of their own, to provide basic provisions to
	themselves or their families. Such basic provisions include, but are not limited
	to, assistance with housing, vehicle or commuting expenses, food, clothing,
	utilities, medical care, and funeral expenses.
