Short Title: Allow County-Wide Challenges/Absentee Ballots. (Public) Sponsors: Senators Cook (Primary Sponsor); Krawiec and Rabin. Referred to: Rules and Operations of the Senate February 8, 2017 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAWS PERTAINING TO PROCEDURES FOR CHALLENGING ABSENTEE BALLOTS TO ALLOW A REGISTERED VOTER TO CHALLENGE AN ABSENTEE BALLOT BY COUNTY VERSUS PRECINCT. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 163-89(b) reads as rewritten: Who May Challenge. - Any registered voter of the same precinct as the absentee votercounty may challenge that a voter's absentee ballot."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
