A JOINT RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE CONFIRMATION OF THE APPOINTMENT OF TONOLA D. BROWN-BLAND TO THE UTILITIES COMMISSION.

Whereas, under the provisions of G.S. 62-10, appointments made by the Governor to membership on the North Carolina Utilities Commission are subject to confirmation by the General Assembly by joint resolution; and

Whereas, the Governor has submitted to the presiding officers of the House of Representatives and the Senate the appointment of ToNola D. Brown-Bland to serve a new term commencing July 1, 2017, and expiring June 30, 2023, on the North Carolina Utilities Commission; Now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring:

SECTION 1. The appointment of ToNola D. Brown-Bland of Alamance County to the North Carolina Utilities Commission for a new term beginning July 1, 2017, and expiring June 30, 2023, is confirmed.

SECTION 2. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
