2 AN ACT TO REALIGN NORTH CAROLINA HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES DISTRICTS 3 FOLLOWING THE RETURN OF THE 2020 FEDERAL DECENNIAL CENSUS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5

SECTION 1. G.S. 120-2(a) through (c) are rewritten to read:

6 For the purpose of nominating and electing members of the North Carolina House of "(a) 7 Representatives in 2022 and periodically thereafter, the State of North Carolina shall be divided 8 into the following districts with each district electing one Representative:

10 (b) The names and boundaries of voting tabulation districts and blocks specified in this section are as shown on the Census Redistricting Data P.L. 94-171 TIGER/Line Shapefiles 11 associated with the most recent federal decennial census. 12

13 If any voting tabulation district boundary is changed, that change shall not change the (c) boundary of a House district, which shall remain the same as it is depicted by the Census 14 Redistricting Data P.L. 94-171 TIGER/Line Shapefiles associated with the most recent federal 15 decennial census." 16

17 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to elections held 18 on or after January 1, 2022.
