Whereas, the health, well-being, and educational success of public school students in			
North Carolina are top priorities of the General Assembly; and			
Whereas, employing school nurses has been shown to have a critical and positive			
impact on the health, well-being, and educational success of public school students in			
kindergarten through grade 12 due to services directed toward keeping students healthy, in class,			
and ready to learn; Now, therefore,

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of			
Public Instruction for the 2024-2025 fiscal year the sum of eighty-nine million dollars			



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(\$89,000,000) in recurring funds to increase the School Health Personnel Allotment. These funds shall be used to increase positions for school nurses in order to provide at least one full-time, permanent school nurse in every school in a public school unit.

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SECTION 3. Funds provided pursuant to this act shall supplement and not supplant any funds from any source already provided for school nurses.

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SECTION 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2024. Section 1 of this act applies beginning with the 2024-2025 school year.
