The 2 Finance Officer for McDowell County shall be the ex officio finance officer of the Authority. 3 (c) Duties. – The Authority shall expend the net proceeds of the tax levied under this act 4 for the purposes provided in this act. The Authority shall promote travel, tourism, and 5 conventions in McDowell County, sponsor tourist-related events and activities in the county, and 6 finance tourist-related capital projects in the county. In performing its duties, the Authority may 7 contract with any person, firm, or agency to advise and assist it and may recommend to the board 8 of county commissioners that county staff be employed for this advice and assistance. Any 9 county staff employed upon a recommendation made by the Authority shall be hired and 10 supervised by the Authority, which shall pay the salaries and expenses of this staff.promoting 11 travel and tourism and for tourism-related expenditures as provided in this act. 12 (d) Reports. - The Authority shall report quarterly and at the close of the fiscal year to 13 the board of county commissioners on its receipts and expenditures for the preceding quarter and for the year in such detail as the board may require. 14

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2024, and applies to the distribution
and use of occupancy tax proceeds on or after that date.
