30	and (d), the local board shall pay each quarter annually, on September 30 of each year, t	
31	remaining gross receipts to the general fund of the city or county for which the board	
32	established, unless some other distribution or some other schedule is provided for by law. If t	
33	governing body of each city and county receiving revenue from an ABC system agrees, the	
34	governing bodies may alter at any time the distribution to be made under this subsection or und	
35	any local act. Copies of the governing body resolutions agreeing to a new distribution form	
36	and a copy of the approved new distribution formula shall be submitted to the Commission	IOr

change in distribution, profits shall be distributed according to the original formula, beginning
with the next quarter.year.

5 (g) Quarterly <u>Annual</u> Distributions. – When this section requires a distribution to be made 6 quarterly, <u>annually</u>, at least ninety percent (90%) of the estimated distribution shall be paid to the 7 recipient by the local board within 30 days of the end of that <u>quarter. year.</u> Adjustments in the 8 amount to be distributed resulting from the closing of the books and from audit shall be made 9 with the next <u>quarterly annual</u> payment. 10"

- SECTION 2. This act applies to Jones County and to the Jones County Alcoholic
 Beverage Control Board only.
