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# Repeal the Rule!

## Update Rules to Streamline and Simplify Administration of Public Funding for Adult Day Services

No Home and Community Care Block Grant (HCCBG) services other than adult day care and day health have maximum rates. Maximum reimbursement rates for adult day services are set out in rule (10A NCAC 06Q .0201.), last updated in 1992. The rule was promulgated under statutory authority in NCGS 143B-181.1(c). There is no fiscal impact to the change. Rate setting for adult day services should be treated like all other HCCBG services to account for differences in different regions and variations in levels of care provided, quality, economics and daily hours of service delivery—six to ten+ hours per day.

### Profile of NC Adult Day Centers

- 85 certified adult day centers (excluding 12 PACE sites) among 50 counties<sup>i</sup>
- 64% of certified centers employ RN or LPN daily (combination centers)<sup>ii</sup>
- Certified daily capacity: 4,998 adults<sup>iii</sup>
- 86% are nonprofit<sup>iv</sup>
- 80% provided daily roundtrip transportation to/from center<sup>v</sup>
- 66% in operation 10+ years<sup>vi</sup>
- Average hours open per day: 10 hours<sup>vii</sup>
- Average operating cost: \$67.67 per day<sup>viii</sup>
- 52% diagnosed with Alzheimer’s disease or other dementia<sup>ix</sup>
- Average length of enrollment: 24 months<sup>x</sup>
